### Part 2 - Details and Expected Performance for Output Expenses

### Part 2.1 - Departmental Output Expenses

### Support Services to Members of the Executive (M47)

### Scope of Appropriation

This appropriation is limited to providing support services for Members of the Executive including office administration; accounting, personnel, information and communication technology; facilities management; media and other advisory services; and provision of residential accommodation.

### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation will decrease by \$1.057 million to \$27.111 million for 2009/10. The decrease relates to:

- a transfer to the non-departmental other expense Members of the Executive's Internal and External Travel to reflect an increase in ministerial travel costs (decrease of \$350,000)
- a transfer to the departmental output expense Visits and Official Events Coordination to reflect an increase in the guests of Government programme (decrease of \$300,000)
- a reclassification of the Ministerial accommodation payments as a non-departmental expense and transfer of funding to the non-departmental other expense Executive Council and Members of the Executive's Salaries and Allowances (decrease of \$200,000)
- a reallocation of shared services costs (decrease of \$149,000)
- a decrease in funding for State Sector Retirement Savings Scheme costs (\$97,000).

These decreases are partially offset by the following increases:

- an expense transfer from 2008/09 to 2009/10 for Sustainable accommodation (increase of \$26,000)
- an increase in funding for KiwiSaver costs (\$13,000).

### VIP Transport (M47)

### Scope of Appropriation

The provision of chauffeur-driven vehicle services for Members of the Executive, the Leader of the Opposition, former Prime Ministers and their spouses, former Governors-General and their spouses, the judiciary, distinguished visitors; and self-drive vehicles for Members of the Executive.

The provision of services to manage programmes for visiting guests of Government; receptions at international airports for the Governor-General, Members of the Executive and guests of Government; State and ministerial functions; commemorative events; and national anniversaries.

### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation will increase by \$299,000 to \$4.736 million for 2009/10. The increase relates to:

- an increase in funding for the guests of Government programme (\$300,000)
- an increase in funding for State Sector Retirement Savings Scheme costs (\$13,000)
- an expense transfer from 2008/09 to 2009/10 for Sustainable accommodation (increase of \$10,000)
- partially offset by a reallocation of shared services costs (decrease of \$24,000).

## Part 3.2 - Non-Departmental Benefits and Other Unrequited Expenses

### Annuities to Former Governors-General, Prime Ministers and their Surviving Spouses PLA (M47)

### Scope of Appropriation

Annuities to former Governors-General, Prime Ministers and their surviving spouses.

### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation will increase by \$62,000 to \$537,000 for 2009/10. The increase relates to recalculation of the actuarial valuation for annuities to former Governors-General, Prime Ministers and their surviving spouses.

# Part 5 - Details and Expected Results for Other Expenses

### Part 5.2 - Non-Departmental Other Expenses

## Executive Council and Members of the Executive's Salaries and Allowances PLA (M47)

### Scope of Appropriation

Payments for civil purposes to the Executive Council and Members of the Executive.

### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation will increase by \$200,000 to \$7.920 million for 2009/10 due to the reclassification of Ministerial accommodation payments as a non-departmental expense and an equivalent transfer of funding from the departmental output expense Support Services to Members of the Executive.

### Members of the Executive's Internal and External Travel (M47)

### Scope of Appropriation

Payments for civil purposes for Members of the Executive's internal and external travel, pursuant to section 20A of the Civil List Act 1979.

### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation will increase by \$350,000 to \$11.790 million for 2009/10 due to an increase in ministerial travel costs and the transfer of funding from the departmental output expense Support Services to Members of the Executive.

### Travel for Former Governors-General and Prime Ministers (M47)

### Scope of Appropriation

Payments for civil purposes, pursuant to section 25 of the Civil List Act 1979.

### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation will decrease by \$212,000 to \$308,000 for 2009/10 due to the recalculation of the actuarial valuation for travel for former Governors-General and Prime Ministers.
